Psychologist Program and Learning Disabilities

Special fee-based
program with a credit-hour system

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Program Vision:

To prepare a psychologist and learning disabilities specialist who is a thinker, professional, practitioner, and researcher capable of continuous self-learning, and to be a leading program that creates success for specialists in the field of learning disabilities.

Program Mission

The program aims to prepare a psychologist and learning disabilities specialist capable of addressing students' problems and providing them with care, especially those with learning disabilities, through comprehensive and integrated cognitive development in the field of psychology, as well as social, cultural, skill-based, technological, national, ethical, physical, and psychological aspects within the framework of societal philosophy, the nature of the age group, and educational, technological, and cognitive developments. This is achieved through the participation of relevant stakeholders and the specialized training of learning disabilities specialists according to national and international standards to enhance their students' performance and improve their quality of life, enabling them to contribute effectively to their community.

What you need to know about the Psychologist and Learning Disabilities Specialist Program:

- The program accepts students who have graduated from secondary school in the humanities and sciences, according to the admission score for the Faculty of Education at Helwan University, in addition to applying the internal standards and conditions of the faculty.
- The study is based on the credit hour system. The student studies 150 credit hours over eight academic levels.
- The coursework fulfills the requirements for specialized preparation, educational preparation, cultural preparation, and field training.
- The courses are divided into required and elective courses. The credit hours per academic level range between 17 and 20 credit hours.
- The program awards a Bachelor of Arts in Education (Psychologist and Learning Disabilities Specialist).

The program also offers graduates opportunities to work:

- in public, private, and international schools.
- in private and community centers.

- In resource rooms in public and inclusive schools.
- In schools dedicated to students with learning disabilities.
- In the field of guidance for students with learning disabilities in specialized centers.
- In civil society organizations concerned with providing support and care for students with learning

disabilities:

- In research and educational centers related to learning disabilities.
- In the field of providing educational and vocational counseling.

Why the Psychologist and Learning Disabilities Program?

- The program achieves excellence and leadership, and provides a competitive advantage for the college due to the scarcity of such a program in all faculties of education at Egyptian universities.
- This program awards a Bachelor of Arts and Education degree specializing in Psychologist and Learning Disabilities, a distinguished specialization at the level of the Arab world.
